

W2E and eviag sign license agreement

Hannover, 20th of April 2009

At the Hannover Fair 2009 W2E Wind to Energy GmbH and eviag AG sign a license agreement for the new wind turbine W93 with an installed power of 2.0 MW, on a non-exclusive worldwide basis.

The W93 is designed for the wind class IIa. It offers the largest “harvest area” of the 2MW-class. Like already for the W100 with an installed power of 2.5 MW the well-proven and patented LARUS Compact®-Drive train concept is applied.

The new founded company eviag from Duisburg has already acquired the rights of the turbine W100, which was established in the market very successful. Eviag is planning a first manufacturing plant in the harbour of Duisburg. The following steps will be new constructions of further manufacturing plants worldwide based on the experience of Duisburg.

Six years ago the Rostock engineering firm W2E has started the R&D of speed variable wind turbines. The Fuhrländer AG has become the position of the first licensee and market launcher. The W100 is produced by Fuhrländer and eviag as well as by the Chinese company A-Power. With the beginning of the W93 development W2E entered directly into the license business. Already in the previous calendar year license agreements were signed with further international turbine manufactures.

W2E and eviag have placed a focus to further common purposes. With a new turbine development W2E will increase the “harvest area” considerably. According to the strategy of the W2E business the optimum cost-efficiency related to the total life cycle of a wind turbine will be a central focus.
